

Welcome Attending TAC-WC and Visiting Beautiful National Parks
(TAC-WC Announcement No. 3)

On January 8, we issued a TAC-WC announcement (No.2), urging you to make room reservation of the hotels for the northbound post-conference tour by the end of January. For those who missed the previous TAC-WC announcement, I like to briefly introduce 2019 TAC-WC.

Now, I would like to bring to your attention the TAC-WC website we have set up, and the speakers we have invited so far.

1. 2019 TAC-WC Website: Tom Yu (TAC-WC committee member living in Arizona) has set up a website for 2019 TAC-WC: <http://tac-wc.org>. The website allows us to upload information on conference as well as post-conference tours, to perform online registration, and to keep track of payments, ...etc. We encourage all of you to visit the website for new information.
2. G-1 Speakers: Ed Huang is in charge of inviting speakers. Realizing the need to pass the baton to the new generation, Ed places equal weight on selecting speakers from generation 1 (G-1) and generation 2 (G-2). We now have invited four G-1 speakers: Cecilia Chueh 陳慧中 (a historian and choir conductor from Vancouver), Josephine Yang 黃河芬 (FAPA President of Southern California Chapter), Ing Hua Hong 洪英花 (well known Judge from Taiwan), Martin Tsai 蔡明峯 (Editor of TaiwanmUS.net). We are still searching for a prominent keynote speaker.
3. G-2 Speakers: Yamei Lee (a former president of NATWA) helps Ed invited five young people with outstanding credentials. They are: Chieh-Ting Yeh, Lily Wang, Christofer Lin, Deana Chuang and Julie Wu. The short bios of all speakers will be posted on the website.
4. TAC-WC Post-Conference Tours (detailed information are on our website): The northbound tour from Salt Lake City to Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks has already sold out. The southbound tour to five national parks in Southern Utah still has seats available. I encourage those who live in the east coast and the Midwest area to come and join this southbound tour. If you are interested in this tour, you should make reservation as soon as possible, via our website. Both north and south tours will depart Salt Lake City on 7/21, and return to SLC on 7/24. On 7/25, there will be a day tour of Salt Lake City. One bus will complete the day tour at 5 pm for those who plan to stay one extra night in SLC. For those who plan to leave SLC on 7/25, the second bus will end the tour earlier and drop the passengers at the airport at 3 pm.

Again we are looking forward to seeing you all in Salt Lake City in July.
