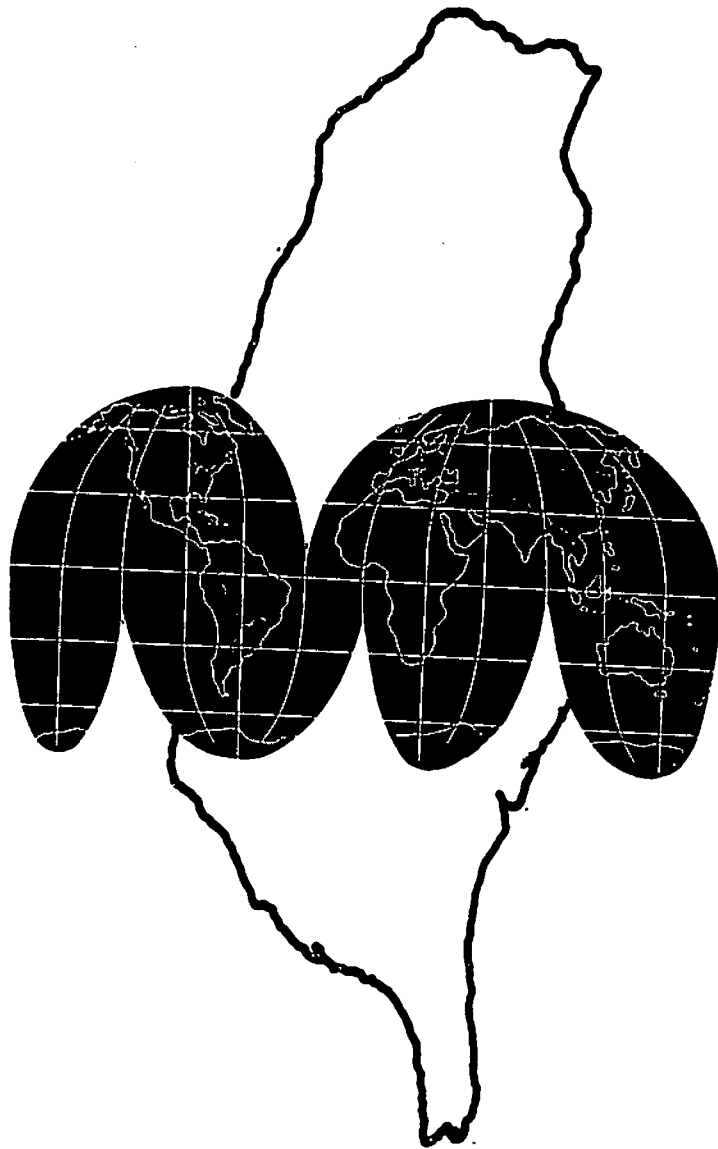

## 吳樂天簡介

吳樂天，本名吳泰嶺，台北市人，現年四十歲，生性豪邁，任俠好義，有悲天憫人的心懷，對人、事、物，觀察敏銳，交遊廣濶，上至政界名流，下至販夫走卒，座上客常滿，壺中茶不空。但生活嚴謹，不喜喝酒應酬，動則練劍道，設立合道館免費教導學生及提供場所，供劍道同好使用，靜則，博覽群書，充實學識。

時常應邀各大專院校演講，並常至各大廟寺巡迴演講，應邀至基督教長老教會、國際同濟會、青商會、扶輪社等社區演講。分文報酬不收，甚至一萬、二萬不等捐獻，並曾三度受行政院文建會之聘，參加民間劇場的說書活動。

吳樂天，秉持取之於社會，用之於社會的信念，在地方上，出錢出力從不後人，尤其在推動民俗方面，及維護台灣本土文化方面，更是不遺餘力。

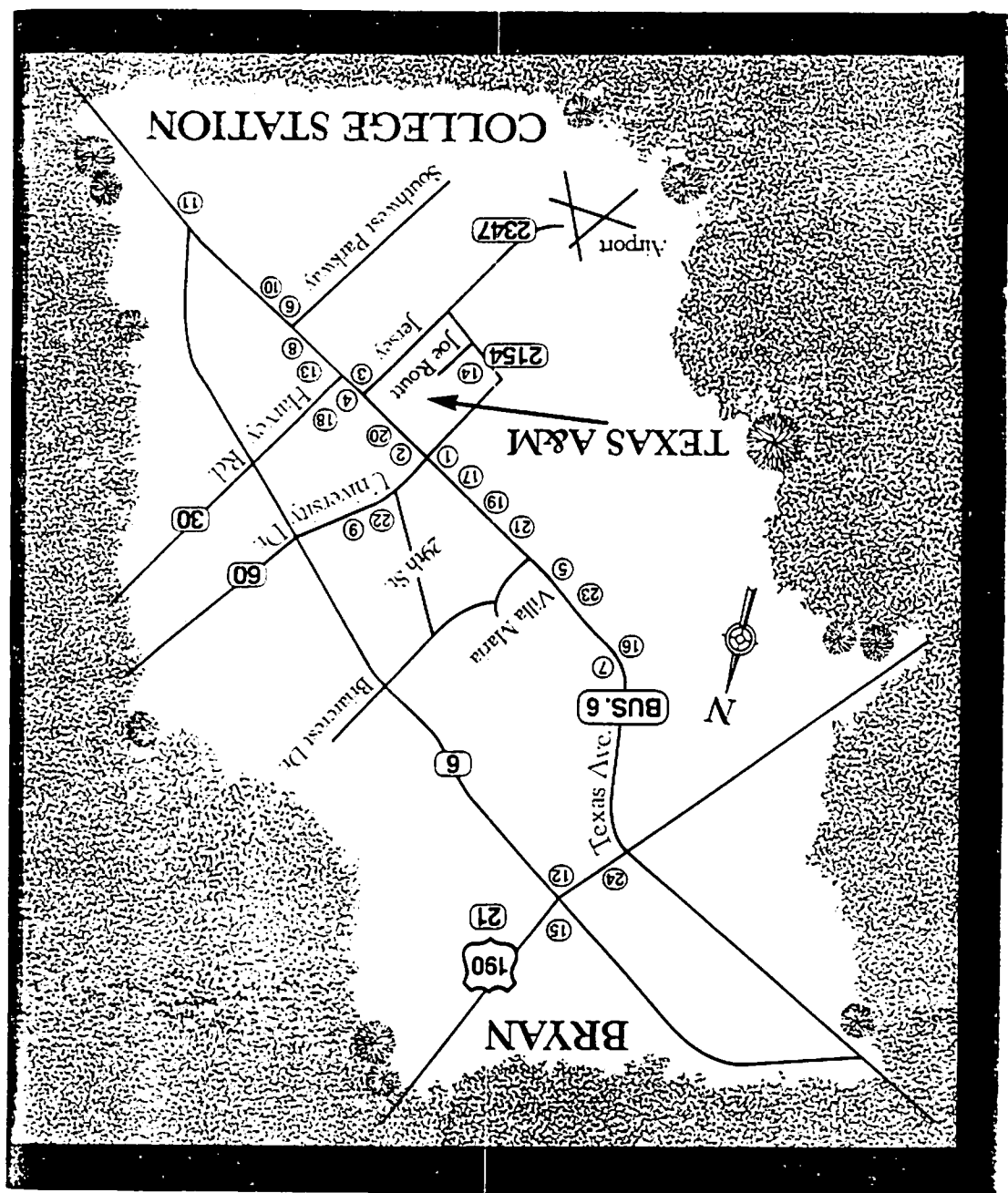
吳樂天具有開創性，敢於創新，他認為「說書，講故事，是一種「語言藝術」，照本宣科老式的說書方法過於落伍。所以主講的故事「廖添丁」、「賣鹽霸」，均沒有劇本，僅在腦中構思劇情，天馬行空，滔滔不絕，二個鐘頭的節目，一氣喝成，精彩絕倫，尤其善於溯古諷今，批評時政，以致某單位特別敏感，多次遭受停播處分。吳樂天主講的節目據保守估計在台灣，每日擁有二百萬以上的聽眾，他的群眾魅力及其知名度，遠勝當紅的電影明星和政治人物。

吳樂天雖不參與政治，却很關心台灣的民主運動和未來台灣的前途。

吳樂天珍惜台灣本土文化，在大專院校演講，均以台語大聲呼籲，學者專家要重視台灣固有文化，勿使東洋、西洋文化的衝擊淪為不中不西變成畸形文化，本土意識漸趨淡薄，台灣的根漸漸的被摒棄掉。在電視頻道主持說書，也純以閩南語製作。在大學的演講稿，以「台灣漫談」為題，自資發行錄音帶，竟然大為暢銷，三集銷售達卅萬卷的紀錄。更免費供應一年的節目帶給加拿大蒙特婁，由中國人自營的中國之聲電台播放，旨在讓異國的學子和僑民，也能聽到純台灣的母語。

最近為擴張推展台灣本土文化的社會層面，特斥資自辦台灣民俗館電影製作社，自製、自導、自演拍攝「台灣英雄廖添丁」，片中純台語配音，凡以上種種皆為維護台灣本土文化而努力。

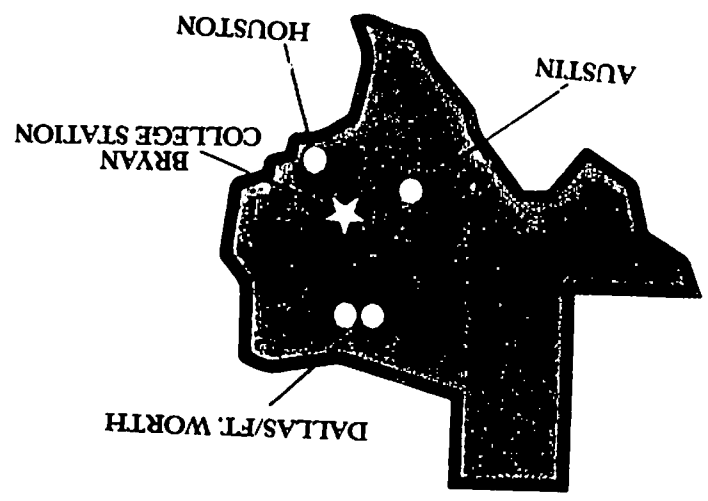




大學城位置圖

Rudder Tower

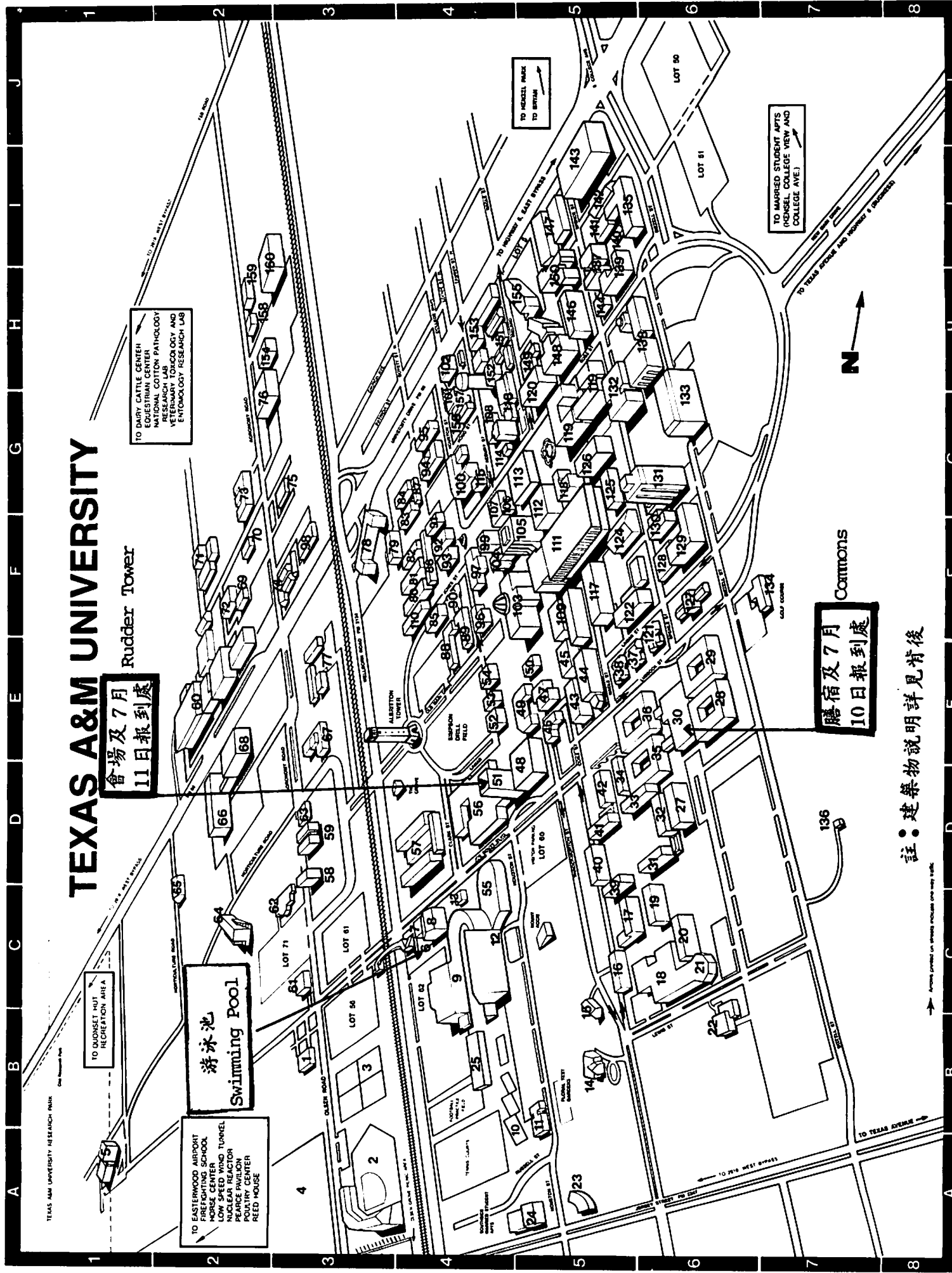

# 附近遊覽區介紹

## 1. 德州農工大學校園

校園佔地 5 千 2 百畝 ( 2 千 1 百公頃 ) Academic Building 為最早的主要大樓。前面的雕像為 Lawrence Sullivan Ross , 他是一九八七至一九九一年德州州長也是一八九一至一八九八年此校校長。校園主要建築物請參閱第 頁, 校園地圖見第 7 頁。

## 2. Texas World Speedway (賽車場)

沿德州 6 號公路距大學城南方 5 哩, 是有名的賽車場, 可容納 2 萬 6 千人, 內有 3 哩的 Grand Prix Course , 2 哩的 Oval Super Speedway 為各種汽車、卡車及摩托車賽車的大場所, 聯絡電話為 693-2500 。

## 3. Brazos Valley Museum (博物館)

位於 3232 Briarcrest Dr. Bryan 這是一座自然科學博物館, 重點為介紹本地附近 Brazos Valley 土長的動、植物群, 並有成人及小孩的節目。免費。聯絡電話為 779-2195 。

## 4. Bryan Public Library (圖書館)

位於 201 E. 26th, Bryan , 這是一棟 1903 年新古典的建築, 藏書主要以文化及內政為主。免費。聯絡電話 823-8021 。

## 5. Cavitt House (古宅)

位於 713 E. 30th, Bryan , 為全鎮最古老的建築, ( 1875 ), 也是本地唯一僅存的意大利式建築。興建人 William R. Cavitt 是當時本地的金融家, 目前本宅不開放讓人參觀。

## 6. Lake Somerville State Recreation Area (州立公園)

沿 FM 60 向西南走廿五哩, 這個公園最大的特色是可以讓遊客騎馬 ( 全德州只有一、二個公園有此設備 ) 整個公園被 Somerville 湖分隔成南、北二個部分, 騎馬的小徑沿著湖的上半端, 5 個露營區 ( 內有洗澡室及廁所 ), 北岸的 Birch Creek Unit 約 640 英畝, 有 103 個露營區, 並供有水電及洗澡間南岸的 Nails Creel Unit 有四十個露營區亦備有水電及洗澡間。每夜每個露營區為 6 元, 聯絡電話北岸為 (409) 535-7763, 南岸為 (409) 289-232392, 這是一個很漂亮又很值得一遊的公園。

Dear Sir:

This is to request that you support the listing of "Taiwanese" as a separate category in the Asia and Pacific Islander group in the 1990 Census form. The total Taiwanese American population is estimated to be several hundred thousands. Most of us are scientists, doctors, engineers, MBA's, Ph. D.'s, lawyers and businessmen. We consider ourselves active and positive forces in the communities we live.

We have excellent nationwide organizations. For instance, the Taiwanese Association of America has over 60 chapters nationwide; the Taiwanese America Citizens League, over 600 members in Los Angeles alone; the Formosan Association for Public Affairs, over one thousand members in 22 chapters; the North American Taiwanese Professors Association, over 400 members in 11 chapters; and, the Taiwanese Christian Church Council of North America, over 70 affiliated churches.

Unfortunately, no one really knows the total number of Taiwanese Americans in this country, where they live and what they do, despite the organizational network mentioned above. Those of us who are active in community affairs are ready, willing and able to assist other immigrants from Taiwan and our coming generations to establish themselves and to assimilate into the American society. To utilize our limited resources effectively and efficiently we need more reliable data to design and implement plans.

On possible alternative to separate classification is to let Taiwanese identify themselves as such in the "other" blank on the census form. This will not work because Census Bureau branches may reclassify the entries as "Chinese" again as they did in the 1980 Census. Moreover, we need a statistics of Taiwanese, not Chinese.

True, people on Taiwan emigrated from China. But for over 85% of the population the emigration took place several hundred years ago. That "Taiwanese" are separate and distinct from "Chinese" is a fact recognized by the U.S. Since 1982 a separate 20,000 immigration quota has been allocated to Taiwanese.

To say Taiwanese are Chinese is to say blacks here are Africans; and Caucasians, Europeans. In the United States, Taiwanese Americans do not associate with the established Chinese community. We do not inhabit the "China towns" nor identify with Chinese organizations.

We feel we know the needs of Taiwanese Americans better than anyone else. With your help we can better serve them and the American society as a whole. Therefore, we are soliciting your help in having "Taiwanese" listed as a separate classification to gather the necessary data.
